The MEAL Advisor reports to the Country Programmes Manager. You are part of the M&E and research department and work closely with your direct colleagues. Furthermore, you work closely together with the education team in Rwanda and with the M&E and Research team members at head office.





If you're our MEAL Advisor, your workweek at the office will include the following highlights:



- 1. You take the lead in **monitoring and evaluating project objectives effectively** and you ensure **lessons** are drawn, documented, and disseminated to inform on-going implementation and future programming.
- 2. You provide coordination, technical support, and advice to VVOB Programme Advisors, Coordinators, and partners in **planning of activities. including coordination of learning:**
 - Works with the programme team and partners to develop indicator sheets and data collection tools, (including digital data tools) and KAP surveys (Knowledge-Attitudes-Practice);
 - Works with programme team to regularly collect data related to programme indicator sheets;
 - Performs regular field visits to ensure the quality of data collected by programme staff and to verify the accuracy of reported data;
 - Supports in the compilation and analysis of quantitative and qualitative programme data and contributes to subsequent reporting;
 - Strengthens and consolidates the MEAL systems, practices, and capacity within VVOB and the programme;
 - Coordinates programme evaluations (baseline, mid-line and end-line);
 - Coordinates and finalizes annual, semi-annual and Quadrimestre narrative reports for our different programmes (**accountability**);
 - Coordinates **learning** within the VVOB programmes based on M&E of activities:
 - ✓ Follows up of resolutions of team meeting
 - Organize learning events within VVOB
 - ✓ Organises research findings dissemination events
- **3.** You **ensure capacity development on M&E** of the partners according to the needs of the partner and particular situations and phases of the projects.
- 4. You take part in internal and external working groups, task forces in Rwanda's basic education sector, particularly related to MEAL.
- 5. You support in data collection (particularly through digital tools) and research on the effects and impact of VVOB's projects within the country.

As the MEAL Advisor, you will also perform any other duty assigned by supervisors in line with the position holder's capacities.


